





DECEMBER in GH

December has always been a time when Ghanaians living abroad returned home to visit their family and friends and enjoy the festive season. The last few years this ritual of December in Ghana has expanded beyond the Ghanaians abroad to the entire African diaspora community as tens of thousands make their way to Ghana for the December holiday season every year.

It was in 2019 during the ‘Year of Return’, when the Ghana Tourism Authority, under the auspices of the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture, officially launched the #DecemberInGH campaign to promote Ghana as a December holiday season destination. This was not only for the Ghanaian diaspora but for the global African family and beyond. The campaign has thus far exceeded expectations putting Ghana on the global map and spotlighting it as the official Christmas party destination. According to Akwasi Agyeman, CEO of the Ghana Tourism Authority, “December in Gh is not just about tourism numbers. It has become a clarion call for the global African family to reconnect around our arts and culture. We are building a new wave that will help promote African music, fashion, food, and many more indigenous activities.”

The campaign includes a signature calendar of events which features activities that have been officially endorsed by the Ghana Tourism Authority through the Beyond the Return Secretariat. It’s expected that Ghana will have record numbers for international arrivals at the airport this year.

December in GH TRAVEL GUIDE

Welcome to Ghana! Your gateway to Africa. The country is known for its history, rich culture and welcoming people. Get ready for the experience of a lifetime as you explore, feel and see the beauty of Ghana. When planning a trip to Ghana there are a few things you must do before you start your journey.

Here are some important travel tips for your trip to Ghana.

HEALTH

Ghana's covid-19 protocols require that all travellers entering the country provide proof of vaccination against Covid-19.

CLIMATE

Ghana is a tropical country that sits close to the Equator and thus has heat all year long. Even during the rainy season the country experiences heat in most areas. When packing your luggage choose lightweight clothing so that you're comfortable throughout your trip.

If you have plans to visit the mountain regions, expect temperatures to be a little cooler during the rainy season. Pack a light jacket, umbrella or rain jacket.

WHAT TO PACK

Carry a power bank for charging your electronic gadgets. Finding power outlets in public spaces may not be as common in Ghana as it is in your home country. Keeping a charged power bank with you will ensure that your electronic devices remain charged when you need them.

SAFETY

Ghana is one of the safest countries in Africa. The country was listed at the 40th safest in the world and second safest in Africa according to the Global Peace Index 2022.

GETTING AROUND

During the month of December Ghana experiences a heavy increase in traffic, especially in the capital city of Accra. It's highly recommended that you plan your journey with added time to accommodate for delays due to the traffic.

TAXI

You'll see taxis from the moment you arrive at the airport. They are one of the most common forms of transportation. They are marked at Black and Yellow vehicles and often have stations around the city where you can either board a taxi solo or join one that is a carpool often referred to as a 'loading taxi'.

Taxis in Ghana don't have meters, leaving you to negotiate the price before you start the journey. However, the 'loading taxi' has a fixed price because it's based on a destination and divided between the number of passengers in the car.

RIDESHARE APPS (UBER, BOLT, YANGO)

Downloading a rideshare app like Uber, Bolt or Yango is a preferred way to get around by making foreign travellers. The ease of not worrying about dire

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The most popular form of local transportation are vehicles referred to as a 'trotro'. These are vans that seat up to 16 people and usually don't have any air conditioning and can be uncomfortable for travellers not used to this mode of transit.

Mass Transit buses are also available during business hours. These are buses that typically operate at certain bus stations and stops. They are not available all day and it's rare to find them in operation on the weekend.

AIR TRAVEL

When visiting different regions, you can fly domestically from Kotoka International Airport. Within the country you can fly from Accra to Takoradi, Kumasi, Tamale, Ho and Sunyani.

FOOD & DRINK

Prepare for your palate to experience the flavour of Ghanaian cuisine, which is filled with plenty of spices and pepper. A typical Ghanaian dish will include a starchy food and a side of meat, fish or stew. Ghanians love pepper so it's always included as a side sauce with nearly every dish. If you're not adverse to pepper, it's important to share that when ordering your food.

To avoid any water borne illnesses, it's best to avoid drinking tap water while you're visiting Ghana.

NIGHTLIFE

Ghana has some of the most vibrant nightlife in Africa. Whether you're in the heart of Accra or in a rural community, Ghanians know how to have a good time. The most popular hotspots known as 'go-to' places for the best parties and DJs are located in the country's capital of Accra.

Urban nightlife in Osu, Labone, East Legon, and Ridge are the most spoken of parts of the city. One thing to note is that Ghanians go from party after party into the wee hours of the morning. With some places really starting to vibe after midnight, you may want to consider taking a nap in the afternoon before a night of partying in Accra during the month of December.

SHOPPING

Accra Mall, West Hills Mall, A&C Mall, Oyarifa Mall, Junction Mall and Achimota Mall are some of the bigger shopping centres in Ghana. All located in the Greater Accra region. There are many other plazas and mini-shopping centres that have been opening as developments grow in the country.

Ghana is a cash society. Meaning most shops and vendors prefer to be paid in cash.


The model we have developed for the period is one of partnership and collaboration and we thank all the event organisers, promoters and organisations that have chosen to be part of this global showpiece.

We encourage Ghanaians to live up to our reputation as a friendly and hospitable people. Let us make the Black Star shine once again.




